Good Afternoon,

I am writing to provide an update for Chilton School District as a result of the state-mandated school closure related to COVID-19 virus.

Based on current information, Chilton Public Schools will hold regularly scheduled classes Monday, March 16, Tuesday, March 17, and Wednesday, March 18. Beginning at 5pm on March 18th through April 5th all district facilities, including the pool and fitness center, will be closed as directed by Governor Tony Evers.

Our students will have the opportunity to engage in enrichment activities utilizing either a digital or hard copy format. These activities are intended to maintain student's skills while away from school. These activities do not replace regular instructional minutes.

Students in grades 2-12 will have the opportunity to check out a Chromebook from school.

- An agreement form will be sent home on Monday, March 16 for parents to review. The signed agreement is due back prior to a Chromebook being sent home.
- If forms are not back prior to the end of the day Wednesday, March 18 parents can stop in the office with the signed form and a Chromebook will be signed out to them.
- If parents would prefer paper/pencil activities - they can be requested by contacting your child's school office.

We continue to monitor and make adjustments as guidance is provided. This includes information on whether some or all lost instructional time will need to be made up.

We will continue to communicate through our district webpage, Facebook, and email. Thank you so much for your patience as we continue to work through this unprecedented time.
