

IMPORTANT REGISTRATION INFORMATION

January 3, 2018

Dear Parents/Guardians:

It is time to begin the registration process for the 2018-2019 school year. We would like to take this opportunity to inform you of the timeline we have developed to register students for next year's courses at Chilton High School (2018-2019). Our goals for the registration process are as follows:

1. To assure all students and their parents understand the course offerings, registration and scheduling process and timelines.
2. To assure all students are able to develop the best schedule of courses possible to meet their short- and long-range needs.

In order for us to be as efficient as possible in meeting the scheduling needs of our students, this timeline requires early decision making from both you and your son/daughter about the courses he/she will choose to take in high school. Those choices will be used to develop a Master Schedule and to make staffing recommendations in February and March. The choices students make will be very important as there is little to no opportunity to change those choices after the registration process is completed. Of course, adjustments will be made because of "extreme" problems, e.g. failure of a recommended prerequisite course or the lack of necessary skills needed to be successful. In the greatest majority of situations, however, the choices students make at the time they register for classes will be **FINAL** - so decisions need to be made carefully.

Continued from last year's scheduling process is online registration. However, as a change from last year, all online registration will take place at Chilton High School during Tiger Academic Block (TAB). Chilton High School believes that course registration is a way for families to have conversations about academic and career planning, course selections and the alignment of those with career goals. It is important that parents have input and approval of the course selections students are making, and as a result, we are requiring that students have their registration documents signed by a parent/guardian prior to registering online at school. We believe the accompanying directions for the registration process are clear and specific. However, if you should have any questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to reach out to Mrs. Denys Mallmann or Mr. Ty Breitlow. *8th grade students will continue to register for courses at Chilton Middle School with the help of the teachers and counselors.*

- **Registration materials, including the Course Description Guide, will be available to students "Online" only – we will not be distributing printed materials to students and/or parents.**
