## **Summer School 2021**

The Chilton School District once again will be providing summer school opportunities. Enrichment instruction along with Math and Reading instruction will be offered in June. Classes will be open for students entering 5K and extend through high school.

## **Transportation**

If you would like your child to ride the bus, you must check the box “Bus Transportation Needed” on the student’s enrollment page when you log on to register for classes. Students must board and depart from the address that is provided when registering for summer school classes. The Chilton Public library will be the location of an in town pick up and drop off point. Busing will also be for anyone living 2 miles or further out from Chilton Middle School. For more information, please feel free to call 920-849-9152 with more specific questions.

## **Enrichment and Academic class Opportunities:**

The Chilton School District summer school enrichment program will take place for three weeks on Mondays through Thursdays from June 7-24. Classes are either 1 hour or 2 hours in length beginning at 8:00 am until 12:00 pm. A wide variety of options will be available ranging from Classroom Fun, Science, Technology, Engineering and Math- (“STEM”), Music & Theater, Fitness & Health, Cooking, and Arts and Crafts. Also available, will be Math or Literacy classes. Math or Literacy will be offered based on staff or parent requests.

## **Covid-19 Protocols**

Summer School 2021  
COVID-19 Protocols

Chilton School District is offering Summer School with the following protocols in place. We will be continuing with the majority of in-person school protocols that we had during the school year with the exception - students will not be in cohorts. This would not allow us to run and operate multiple enrichment choices for our students. To offset this we are limiting class sizes to 15 students per a course. This will allow for ample social distancing of 6' in each classroom. If a student is in a classroom setting they will be given an assigned seat.

Summer School begins at 8:00 am. Please do not drop your child off prior to 7:50 am when the doors open for students to enter the building. This will assist with not having a congregation of students outside prior to the start of the day. Please review what door your students should be coming in based off of their first class of the day. This information will be sent out after sign up is completed.

1. Classes sizes are limited to 15 students per class so that 6' social distancing can occur. There are two courses that will be maxed at 20 students and that is due to the larger room that is available.
2. All students and staff will be masked.
3. All students will have their temperature taken prior to their first class of the day. If a student does not have a 8 am class then their temperature will be taken in the Middle School Office. Any student that showcases a 100.4 or greater temperature will be asked to not attend that day and will not be able to return until they are 24 hours symptom free.
4. Hand Sanitizer stations are available in every classroom and units in the hallways.
5. In between each class change that occurs teachers will be cleaning table tops prior to the next group of students entering the classroom.
6. When possible, classes will be held outside.
7. Students will be given an entrance door to school based on their first hour class. This will either be the Elementary Main Entrance, Middle School Main Entrance, or the Bus Entrance for any student receiving transportation.
8. Hallway signs will be in place to help the flow of students in between classroom changes to help maintain distance as students move from class to class.
9. Each room will be cleaned daily by the maintenance staff to set up for the following day of classes.
10. Students who are taking the bus will be required to wear a mask on their drive to and from school each day.
11. Only visitors for essential purposes will be allowed in schools and will be required to wear a face covering.
12. Water Fountains will not be accessible. With the installation of water bottle fill up stations around the school students are encouraged to bring a water bottle.

13. Maintaining Social Distancing will be followed as much as possible.
14. Teachers will use limited manipulatives that are touched or handed out. Items that are used will be cleaned prior to others touching them.
15. If a student is outside for class they will be able to remove their mask if they are maintaining a social distance of 6'.
16. Students will be encouraged to use hand sanitizer or wash their hands when moving from classroom to classroom.

#### Before the School Day

1. Parents are asked to keep children home if they are displaying any symptoms of illness.
2. Buses will be cleaned before each route.
3. Parents are encouraged to transport their children.
4. There will not be a breakfast option at school so please make sure your child has breakfast. Students are allowed to bring a snack however they will not be able to share it with other students.

If a positive case occurs Summer School Administrators will be looking at close contacts within the time frame that we are given. When we review these lists we will be looking at any student that was within 6 ft of the positive case for more than 15 min. With class sizes being limited to 15 and desks being 6ft away we are hoping for limited impacts on any student or family. In the event that your child needs to quarantine there will not be a virtual option available.
