

What do the numbers mean?

3

Meeting Expectations

This means the student has successfully demonstrated the necessary skills in that standard.

2

Approaching Expectations

This means a student is part of the way towards demonstrating the necessary skills, but hasn't quite gotten the full standard yet.

1

Attempting Expectations

This means a student has made an attempt at the standard, but has a lot of growth to do to reach demonstration of all necessary skills.

***INC - Incomplete**

This means the student has not shown any demonstration of this standard, so a score cannot be given at this time.

To Attain Credit

Students need to receive a score of 2.4 or higher to receive credit for a class.

Students cannot have any INCs or 1s in any of the STANDARD scores to receive credit.
